POSITION TITLE: Aircraft Survival and Flight Equipment Repairer

Individual selected will be ordered to full time duty (state) in Active Guard/Reserve status under Title 32 USC 502(f). Benefits will be commensurate with grade/rank and years of service.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: Members of the Arkansas Air National Guard. (This announcement runs concurrently with a Technician announcement for the same position.)

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Must possess or meet requirements for entry into 2A7X4 (requires a minimum Mechanical aptitude score of 44). PULHES 333133. Persons selected for a full time military duty tour must, at the time of entry, have sufficient retainability to complete 20 years of full time National Guard duty and/or active duty prior to his/her mandatory separation date, and be able to serve at least five consecutive years prior to his/her eligibility for military non-disability retirement or retainer pay.

PLACEMENT FACTORS: Selectee will be subject to uncommon tours of duty, rotational shift assignments and overtime duty. May be required to fly in military or commercial aircraft for TDY purposes. Prior to entry on tour, selectee will meet the physical qualifications outlined in Chapter 7, AFI 48-123. Must be medically qualified by ANG physical examination within 12 months prior to entry on military duty. Personnel over age 40 must complete an exercise stress EKG. Selectee will participate in unit of assignment during UTAs and Annual Training periods including deployments, special projects and exercises. Upon assignment, must be a member of the 188th FW, and assigned to a compatible military position in AFSC 2A7X4, or compatible.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES: The incumbent develops working sketches containing dimensional data whenever specifications are not available. Draws individual patterns or changes existing patterns for the purpose of producing custom items and covers for a wide variety of equipment or components. Performs required inspections and shop repair on all parachutes, survival equipment, flotation equipment, fabric leather, and rubber and aircrew personal flying equipment as prescribed in appropriate technical publications. Examines parachutes to detect rips or tears, stains, and/or other signs of damage or deterioration.

SUMMARY OF DUTIES CONTINUED: Cleans, repairs and packs sophisticated multiple personnel, cargo and deceleration parachutes. Inspects and identifies property according to condition. Designs and manufactures standard fabric and leather items required in all functional areas assigned and/or attached to the 188th FW. Operates, repairs and maintains sewing machines, punch presses and other related equipment. Performs technical order compliance and modifications on parachutes. Serves as on-the-job trainer in the survival equipment shop. Performs other duties as assigned.
